RCI's Math Teachers are committed to helping your student be successful, but there are some ways parents can help too!

- Have high expectations for your child
- Talk about mathematics in a positive way
- Encourage your child to use a daily planner
- Encourage personal responsibility for learning
- Emphasize that effort is as important as ability
- Talk about the importance of homework
- Encourage a regular time and place for completing homework
- Even when homework has not been assigned, encourage daily review
- Encourage your child to ask for help when they are having difficulty
