#### <u>Science Update</u> (Brad Kennedy, ACL - Science)

Two University of Toronto Medical School students recently visited Mr. Kennedy's grade 12 Biology class and Ms. Fife's grade 12 Chemistry class to discuss an exciting opportunity to pair up with U of T medical school student mentors. The mentorship program runs throughout the academic year and meets up once a month. Mentors give interactive science presentations and groups enter into discussions, brainstorm questions and experiments to hone their scientific skills. For the high school students, this mentorship culminates in a scientific presentation to a group of elementary students in April, one which they will develop with their mentors throughout the year. Our Runnymede grade 12 science students seemed really excited about joining this program and we look forward to sharing more news as it develops!

#### <u>RCI Breakfast Club</u> (Karen McCrimmon, ACL – Equity & Wellness)

The Runnymede Breakfast Club is a group of dedicated students who help to cook healthy and hot breakfasts 4 mornings a week. Arriving at 7:30 am, the students help to cook and prepare a delicious meal for students who are too busy (or late waking up) in the mornings. With menu items such as cereal, toast, milk, fruit, vegetables, smoothies, grill cheese, scrambled eggs, mini-pizzas, french toast and pancakes, there is never an excuse to attend class hungry. The Breakfast Club is supported by the TDSB Nutrition Program and Foodshare Toronto.

Although breakfast is free to all who would like to come and share a meal with us, we ask that donations of loose change be made when possible. On late-start Thursdays, breakfast bars, yogurt tubes and fruit can be found on a cart outside the cafeteria or main office.
