Thank everyone on school council for efforts this year, and our students and families, to our admin (Leigh Thornton, Rosalie Fine and former VP Kate Ferguson + clerical + caretaking teams), the ACL + program leads, guidance and all teaching staff. All have worked hard to be flexible and pivot as the year has unfolded.  Scheduling of remainder of year + next Fall continues. Credit rescue starts June 23 <sup>rd;</sup> Acknowledged the hard work done to support every student via guidance + specialized program. Messaging about delivery of report cards will be forthcoming – likely via email as in past quadmesters; Almost completed hiring to backfill vacancies caused by retirements and 4/5 sabbaticals. Good range of applicants applying and pleased with results. Responding to parent question on ensuring integration across subjects for programs (such as Masters) – will continue to support this; Waiting to hear final count for VPs with Mountview (1 allocated to RCI).  Current direction from Minster of Education is to schedule for quadmesters starting in Sept 2021.  A parent advised that there are petitions circulating in Ontario to request the Minster of Education return to normal school scheduling (semestered for RCI) in the Fall if health measures support this. 			Ms. Thornton (VPs Report):  In June will be highlighting pride and national Indigenous month. Students have created a GSA (Gender / Sexuality Alliance) group for RCI + Mountview – teachers + students. Intent is to create a safe space for all + connect with students. Will be having workshops for grade 9/10 students with external TDSB approved provider to focus on educating students around homophobia, encouraging the creation of inclusive spaces, developing language that is supportive.  In classes, in addition to the Land Acknowledgement Agreement, teachers will be encouraging moments of reflection.  Organizing a speaker for the GSA who is a poet laurate and well-regarded spoken word artist – students feel a real connection with him; Reading for Explicit Change continues with the last meeting in 2 wks; During the last few meetings have focused on asking for, giving, accepting, and acting on feedback from peers/staff and RCI families.  Mental health continues to be an issue for many, and the school staff are working hard to
			support students. If families notice students missing classes, or needing support please teach out to staff who are there to provide support and make sure no students slip through unsupported.  Adin and ACLs and Guidance brainstorming on how they can create specialized programming for all students that is integrated across subjects so students can find connections with school that motivate them.
