VP Report & Update	Admin	 Principal Update VP Updates 	Mr. Edwards: Huge thanks to ACL + admins as return with ever lifting restrictions + balancing staying attentive to being aware; Shout-out in particular to Ms. Bylykbashi for taking a leadership role in preparing for musical – more info + dates coming out shortly. Students + teachers preparing for provincial testing as appropriate. The OSSLT (Ontario Secondary School Literacy test) is waived as a graduation requirement for current cohort of grade 12s. EQAO will resume in the Spring. Current grade 12s exempted from OSLT. Extra-curricular activities will begin to be offered throughout the Spring. Initial planning for a celebration of athletics for students being considered for the Spring. Prom will proceed in person. Yearbook planning has begun. Many departments are running help sessions at lunchtime and afterschool – especially science and math. Please encourage students to connect with the teachers – the sessions may be run by other teachers but will cover material the students have questions on. A reminder: April 5 th is parent teacher interviews- this is an important opportunity for parents to touch base with teachers before mid-term marks are released. The cafeteria is open for students to eat in however food service is not available. However, the Breakfast program with pre-packaged food options is still ongoing. For Phys Ed classes, the teachers are exploring how to incorporate swimming as a module within the classes in the time remaining (the pool is now open).			

6.	Bylaw Update	Jackie Marrie	•	Update	The PCEO has advised that the Draft of the new By-Laws required for School Councils to use to communicate changes to by-laws is not available yet. Awaiting to hear back from the PCEO. Until then, the current school by-laws remain in effect. Once the Draft Update is available, the proposed new by-laws will be circulated for parents for review and approval. The School Council is recommending the proposed by-laws be accepted as is once available.
7.	Financial Update	Robynne Ostry	•	Update	The Parent Council bank account has been closed+ proceeds deposited into the school non board account. The executive voted to donate \$575 towards the yearbook to support every student receiving a yearbook. The fundraising letter (Direct Donation Campaign) was sent out on March 25 th . When parents use the link to donate a tax receipt is generated regardless of the amount donated but when they donate via a cheque, receipts are generated only for donations \$25 and above. Robynne will stay in communication with the office about the progress of the fundraising campaign and work with Janelle to post the letter on the website and via the social media channels. Considering a direct appeal to parents of graduates — specifically to have them donate monies for graduation and prom.

9.	Mountview Update	Carla Granger	•	Update	Programming with the pool has started and the policies, scheduling, and processes to support this has been well done. Discussions are starting about the possibility of a community garden having Mountview registered as an Eco school. Nicole from TPL is coming to the Mountview meeting tomorrow to present. Mountview is hosting an egg hunt + picnic for students and families on April 10 th . Some discussions have been ongoing about the SIP (School Improvement Plan) which is an ongoing, living document. Discussions have begun about formalizing a snack program for students in need. Mountview continues to look at fundraising opportunities — have had some successful programs this year and raising funds in support of families in need. Carla will be following up with Ms. Bylykbashi about the upcoming musical and potential cross-over opportunities with Mountview Students. RCI Students have not yet re-established their visitation/support with Mountview students.
